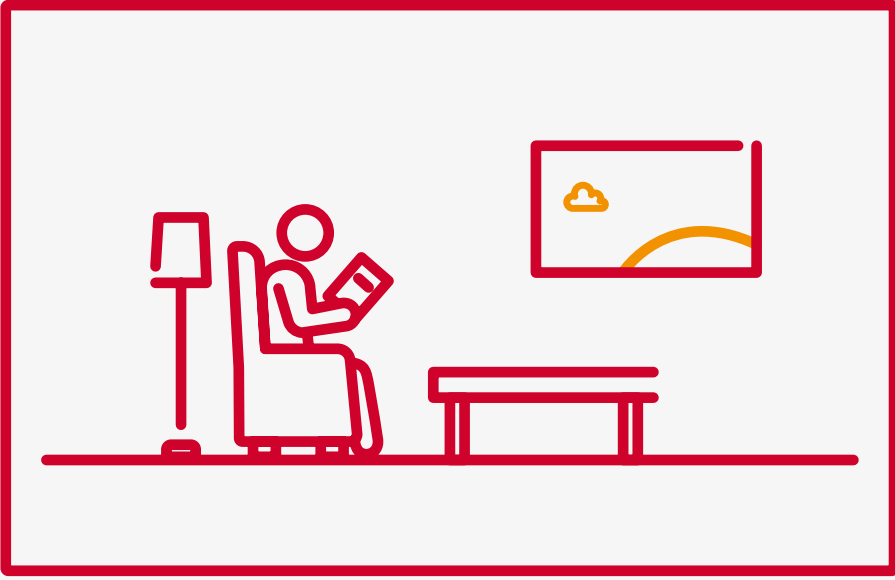
### Introduction

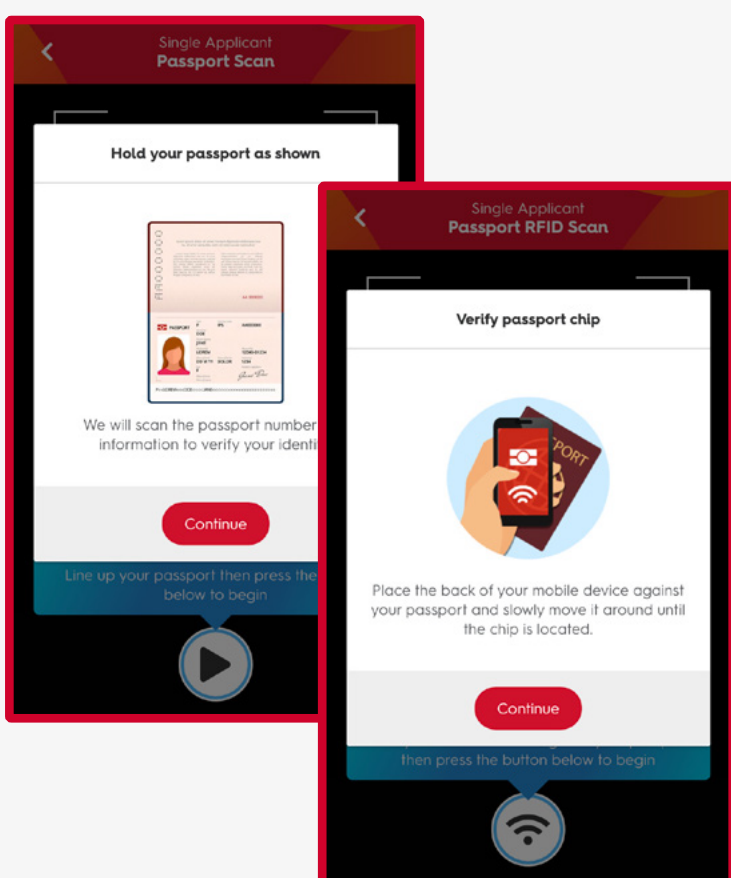
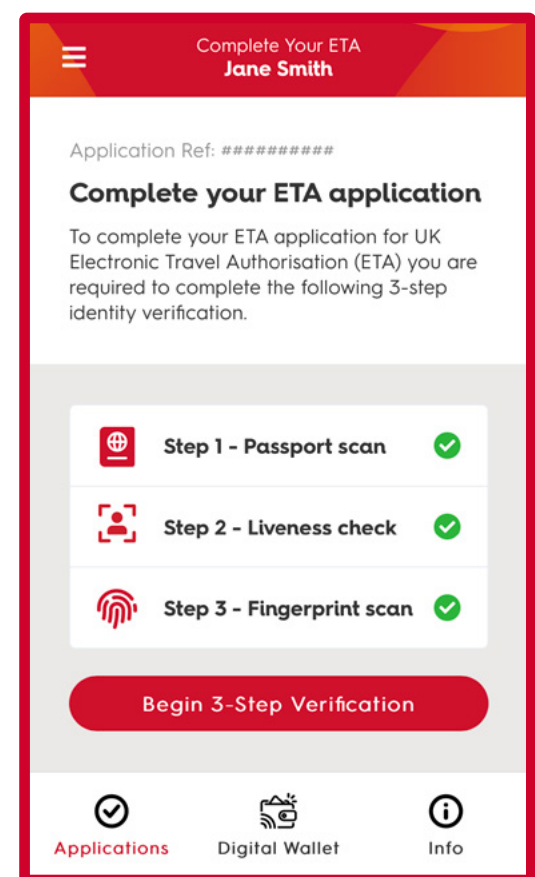

The app allows you to securely complete your Electronic Travel Authorisation, or ETA, application from the comfort of your own home at a time that suits you.

This remote identity enrolment process enables a frictionless, no contact user experience, supporting the vision of seamless border crossings. There are three identification steps as part of your ETA application.



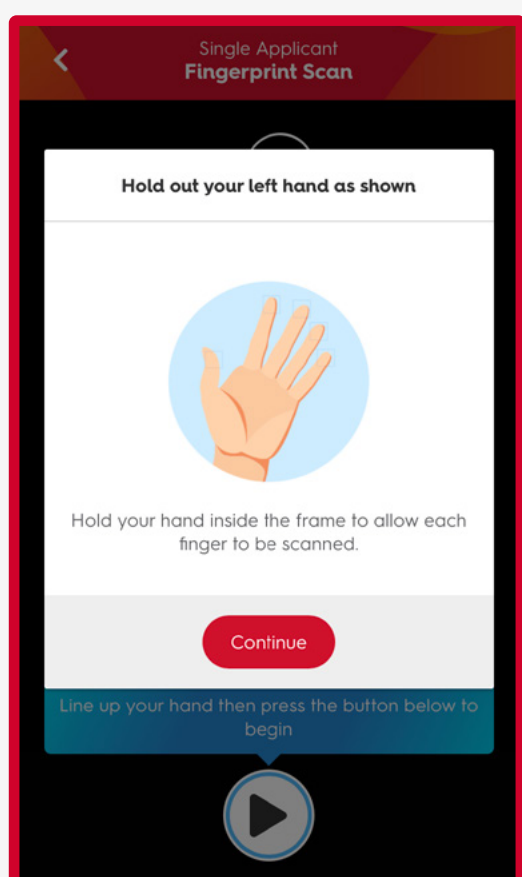
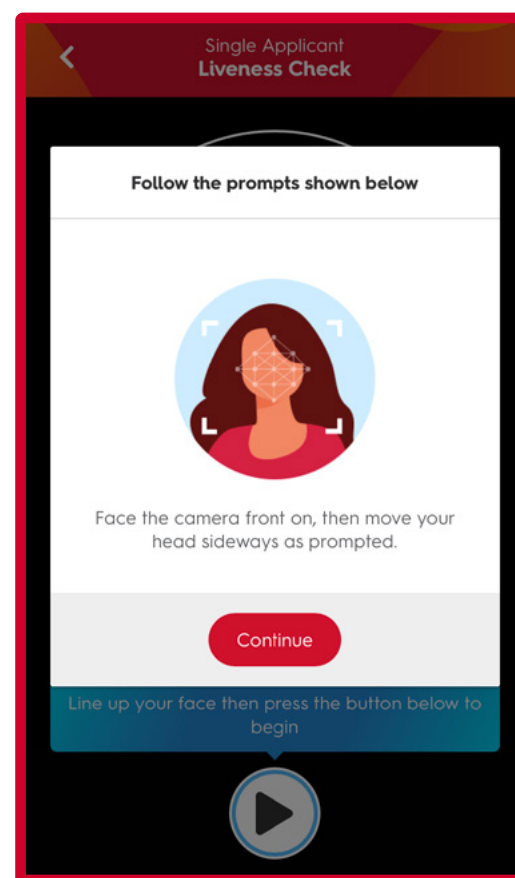
## 1. Passport scanning & RFID chip check

Open your passport to the photo page and align to the on-screen guide. The app will scan your passport.

Place the back of your mobile device against your passport and slowly move it around until the chip is located.

## 2. Facial liveness

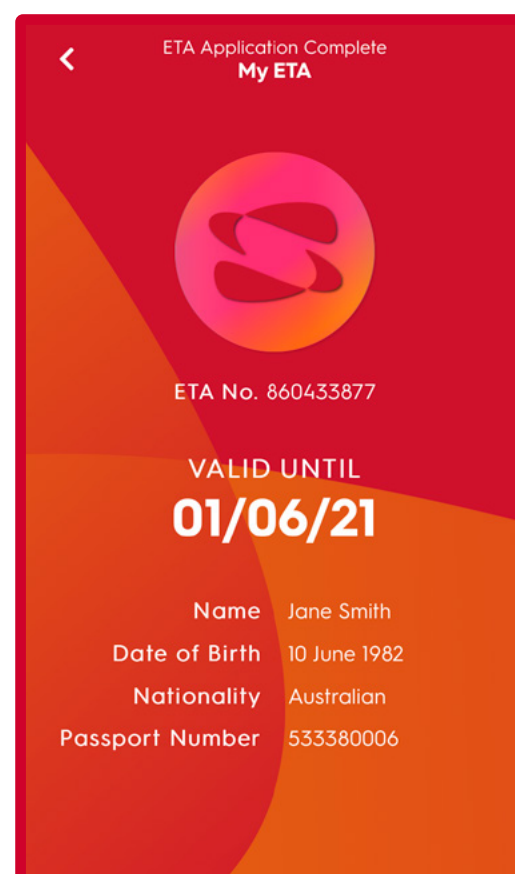
Line up your face with the on-screen guide and follow the instructions.



The app simulates your application being processed and you will receive a notification when your ETA has been approved. You can now view your ETA in your digital wallet.

## 3. Enrol fingerprints

Line up your hand with the guide shown on screen. The app will scan your fingerprints. Repeat with the other hand.





Prior approval to travel means that, at the border, a passenger's identity can be validated using contact-free technologies against an approved ETA for a seamless and secure journey.
